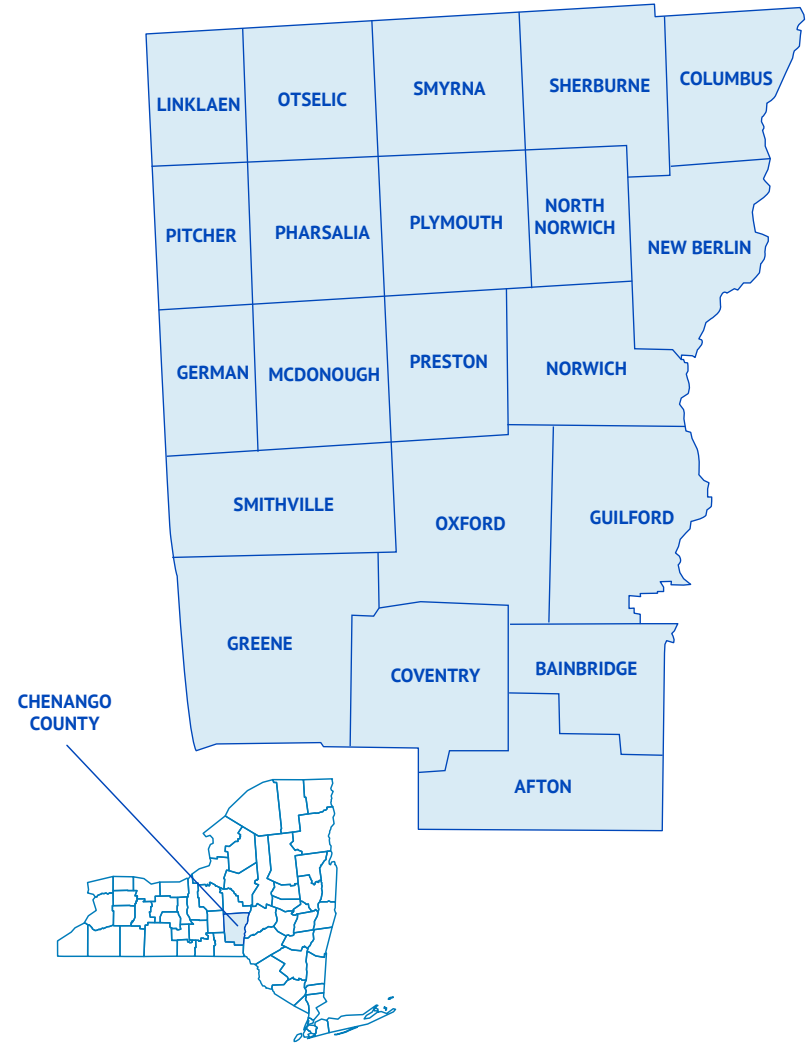

4,356 acres are available for bird watching, X-country skiing, fishing, hunting and trapping. In 1926, the area became the first game refuge acquired by the State. Access depends on the weather conditions.

PHARSALIA WOODS STATE FOREST

9,000 acres in the towns of Plymouth and Pharsalia, providing hiking, biking,

fishing, hunting, trapping, snowmobiling, snowshoeing, and skiing. The forest contains six miles of the Finger Lakes Trail. Features an accessible viewing platform overlooking the 25-acre Round Pond.

SPRING

Day 2 Once the snow melts and temperatures start to rise, the golf courses re-open. Spend a day on the links at one of our outstanding courses (for a complete list, see page 11).

Reward yourself for a great day of golf with dinner at the club and follow up with a locally crafted beer at the **Bullthistle Brewing Co.** in Sherburne or **Hidden Springs Brewhouse** in Norwich.

SUMMER

Day 1 Outdoor activities abound during the summer months, when the weather here is nearly perfect. Check out the hiking and biking opportunities in **Pharsalia Woods State Forest**. Don't miss the new viewing platform overlooking Round Pond, which gives you the perfect vantage for observing the natural wonders around you.

Bowman Lake State Park isn't far from here, and makes a great spot to camp for the night. Cool off with a swim in the beautiful lake, and end your day with a campfire and s'mores before drifting off to sleep beneath the stars.

Day 2 Mid-summer is the perfect time to pick blueberries! Bring a bucket and some sunscreen, and spend a few hours amid the bushes at **Kuhn's U-Pick Blueberries** in Oxford. You'll come away with enough berries to bake or freeze and enjoy throughout the year.
